



## **SUMMARY OF MOBILITY PROJECT FOR HIGHER EDUCATION STUDENTS AND STAFF BETWEEN PROGRAMME AND PARTNER COUNTRIES WITHIN ERASMUS+ PROGRAMME PROJECT NO. 2017-1-PL01-KA107-037348**

The Mobility Project for Higher Education Students and Staff between Programme and Partner countries within Erasmus+ programme (financial agreement no. **2017-1-PL01-KA107-037348**) was implemented by the Lublin University of Technology (LUT) from 1.06.2017 to 31.05.2019. The project was carried out in compliance with LUT and PUs internationalization strategies, 2014-2020 ECHE, Erasmus Policy Statement and Interinstitutional Agreements. Project was carried out in cooperation with partner universities from Algeria, Armenia, Belarus, Brazil, Russian Federation, Georgia, Honduras, Indonesia, Japan, Cambodia, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Kosovo, Morocco, Panama, Tunisia, Ukraine and Uzbekistan.

In total 37 partner universities participated in the project, out of which 35 carried out mobilities (incoming and/or outgoing): Al-Farabi Kazakh National University, Belarusian National Technical University, Belarusian State Technical University, Belarusian State University, National Research University-School of Economics, Universidade Federal do Amazonas, Georgian Technical University, Ibn Tofail University, Kazakh National Research Technical University, Kuban State University, Kyiv National University of Construction and Architecture, Kyrgyz State Technical University, National University of Uzbekistan, National Polytechnic University of Armenia, Kumamoto University, Kyushu University, Saga University, National University Of Water Management and Nature Resources Use, Osh Technological University(OUT), Penza State University, Royal University of Phnom Penh, University of Sfax, People's Friendship University of Russia, Francisco Morazán National Pedagogical University, Technological University of Panama, Universidade do Estado do Pará, Universidade Estadual de Montes Claros, Abdelmalek Essaâdi University, University Abdelhamid Ibn Badis Mostaganem, University of Tlemcen, University Moulay Ismaïl, University of Muhammadiyah Malang, Taraz State University, Ternopil Ivan Puluj National Technical University, Samarkand State University.

Representatives of LUT and partner universities participated in the project - students, academic teachers, administrative staff. The main fields were: mechanics and machine construction, informatics, architecture, management. 166 mobilities were completed, including incoming to LUT: 56 students, 40 teachers for teaching and 22 staff for training. Project met with a great interest, and the number of completed mobilities is higher than awarded by 8. The budget was completed in 98.69%. Project primarily aimed at implementing high-quality mobilities, extending the lasting cooperation with PUs through the implementation of EU project. The possibility for PUs to become acquainted with the Erasmus + programme, conditions of application and project implementation, was also of great significance.

Office of International Education, faculty coordinators and Erasmus+ university coordinator were responsible for the project quality and management. PUs appointed representatives of international offices and other units for the purpose of the project

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management. Candidates and participants were not discriminated on grounds of nationality, sex nor age. Principles of equal treatment and information access were applied.

The percentage of women and men in the project was: 59% men and 41% women. Participants were eligible to participate and received scholarship in accordance with the allocated budget and with the rules approved by LUT and accepted by partner universities. Project implementation allowed for the development and improvement of language skills; social, intercultural and professional competences of the participants; exchange of best practices in education and organization of the university administrative tasks; promotion and modernization of the educational offer of universities. Students gained knowledge and experience in an international environment, therefore became more attractive on the job market. The representatives of partner universities exchanged their experiences in higher education. Partner universities strengthened their local, regional and international position, became interesting partners for other institutions.

A positive image of students, scientists and entrepreneurs from partner countries is being created. As a result, the internationalization factor of partner universities is growing. Cities and regions, where they are located, are being promoted and developed. Project was also an opportunity to disseminate the information about full-degree studies in English at LUT among candidates from partner countries. International cooperation resulted in upgrading LUT's position in the Lublin region, extending LUT's educational offer for international students. Project had a positive impact on the participants, PUs, other organizations and persons. Its implementation complies with the objectives formulated in internationalization strategies and the Agenda for the Modernisation of Europe's Higher Education Systems.
